Sect 3.6(a)(2)(i) - Numerous pens throughout facility have torn tin roofs on sides + broken wire on the pens which can injure the dogs. Correct by 10/31/96

line 30 Space + Additional Requirements Sect 3.6  
① Sect 3.6(c)(i) twenty (20) cages in holding barn contain too many dogs in the available floor space. Correct by next shipment of puppies

② Sect 3.6(c)(iii) 19 cages in the puppy holding pen do not have 6" of headroom between the top of the puppy's head + the top of the cage. A few adult dogs throughout the facility do not have 6" of headroom. Correct above immediately.

line 36 Cleaning + Sanitation Sect 3.11  
① Cleaning Sect 3.11(a) - Pen near the storage shed with 3 dogs in it + large dog pens in outdoor raised pens are not be cleaned of feces daily. Correct by 10/3/96

② Sanitation Sect 3.11(b) red barn has accumulation of hair/dirt/feces under pens on wood + wire + on floor. Barn does not appear to have been sanitized within the last 2 weeks. Correct by 10/4/96

line 45 Identification Sect 2.50(b) 18 adult dogs in red barn, which are being held back for breeding stock are not identified with an official USDA tag or tattoo. Correct by 10/9/96.
